

Chesterfield Stadium Project Scores Highly at Recent CCS Audit

Following a previous visit by the Considerate Constructor Scheme at which the site scored 38.5 the team at our Chesterfield FC New Stadium project were delighted to achieve 38 on the second visit.

Although this was a drop of 0.5 points, the CCS scoring criteria makes scoring 5 in the same subject extremely difficult, therefore the scoring of 38 on the second visit shows the continued commitment by the team.

This should definitely put the site in the top 7% of all contracts that are audited ensuring them either a Gold, Silver or Bronze at next years awards.

The new 10,388 seat stadium is due for completion this summer.
