### **GB Building Solutions awarded seventh St Andrew's project**

GB Building Solutions has won its seventh project from St Andrew's Healthcare in just 5 years taking GB's total provision of care facilities in England to over £250 million.

GB has undertaken over £70 million worth of schemes for St Andrew's including the current project at William Wake House where they are providing a £46m Residential Mental Health Facility due for completion in Autumn 2010.

Martin Smout, chairman and chief executive of GB Building Solutions says, "We have now built more than £250million of care projects in the last five years. This is our seventh project with St Andrews which is testament to the success of our partnership and solutions driven approach with the people we work with."

GB will refurbish an existing ward to provide a brain injury unit for young people, known as Kemsley East. The new unit will offer highly specialised services for young people aged between 13 and 18 years who have an acquired brain injury. Opened in 1979, Kemsley was the UK's first specialised service for Acquired Brain Injuries and now houses the National Centre for Brain Injury Rehabilitation.

The project, worth £1.8m will be to refurbish the interior of the Kemsley building and to extend the building to include a visitors' room, indoor activity area and a new orangery. GB will bring the unit up to low secure standards and provide a modern and more comfortable environment for the patients, staff and visitors.

The project is due for completion in October this year.
