

Ground Breaking Ceremony at University of York

Construction work has started on the new Centre for Immunology and Infection which will help researchers learn more about infectious diseases, translate scientific discoveries into new treatments and conduct clinical trials.

To mark the start of construction a ground breaking ceremony took place earlier this week.

Professor Paul Kaye, the Centre's Director, said: "The University is already at the forefront of research into immunology and infectious diseases. This new building will further enhance our work developing new drugs and vaccines to combat globally important diseases. It will also expand the range of training available to graduates of the Hull York Medical School and so support efforts to retain locally-trained doctors in the area."
