

New Contract Awarded at University of York

We are delighted to announce that we have been awarded a new £3m project at University of York.

The new building will accommodate expansion of the CII, providing additional research and office accommodation. The new facilities for volunteer studies and for conducting first-to-man trials will provide greater opportunities for translational research.

The new Wolfson Laboratories, supported by a £1m donation from the Wolfson Foundation, will allow the University to develop further cutting edge in-vitro models for the assessment of immune modulators, microbicides and pathogen-specific drugs.

Work is due to start on site in June 2009 for a period of 46 weeks.
